Come Alive

Monday

when you ARRIVE....

The hand of the LORD was upon me, and carried me out in the spirit of the LORD, and set me down in the midst of the valley which was full of bones, [Ezekiel 37:1](#)

ARRIVE to reach a destination; to make an appearance; to be near in time; to reach by effort or thought

IN ORDER TO BE ALIVE
YOU MUST BE READY TO ARRIVE

the formula for ARRIVAL

1. BUY THE TICKET
2. GET ON THE BUS
3. TRUST THE DRIVER

you BUY THE TICKET when you say

- NO
- ENOUGH
- I WILL
- I BELIEVE
- HELP ME
- YES LORD

you GET ON THE BUS when you

- SIGN UP
- JOIN UP
- PARTICIPATE IN
- GET IN THE GAME

Trusting the DRIVER requires that you must

- BELIEVE he knows WHERE TO GO
- BELIEVE he knows HOW TO GET THERE
- SUBMIT to HIS TIMETABLE
- PLACE your LIFE in HIS HANDS

Wednesday

GOD will REVIVE....

*Thus saith the Lord GOD unto these bones; Behold, **I will cause breath to enter into you, and ye shall live:** [Ezekiel 37:5](#)*

REVIVE to restore to consciousness or life; to restore from a depressed, inactive, or unused state: to renew in the mind or memory

SURVIVE living or continuing longer than another person or thing : the continuation of life or existence

WHERE THERE IS 'REVIVAL'
THERE IS NO NEED FOR 'SURVIVAL'

BELIEVE THE POWER

*And he said unto me, Son of man, can these bones live? And I answered, **O Lord God, thou knowest.** [Ezekiel 37:3](#)*

RECEIVE the PROPHET

*Again he said unto me, **Prophecy upon these bones, and say unto them, O ye dry bones, hear the word of the LORD.** [Ezekiel 37:4](#)*

ACHIEVE THE PROMISE

*So I prophesied as he commanded me, **and the breath came into them, and they lived, and stood up upon their feet, an exceeding great army.** [Ezekiel 37:10](#)*

REVIVER

DEAD and knows it

trusts in GOD

breathes LIFE

SURVIVOR

DEAD and doesn't know it

trusts in SELF

takes LIFE

by any means NECESSARY

Friday

and you'll become ALIVE

*Blow the trumpet in Jerusalem! Announce a time of fasting; call the people together for a solemn meeting. Bring everyone—the elders, the children, and even the babies. Call the bridegroom from his quarters and the bride from her private room. **The priests, who minister in the LORD'S presence, will stand between the people and the altar, weeping. Let them pray, "Spare your people, LORD! They belong to you, so don't let them become an object of mockery. Don't let their name become a proverb of unbelieving foreigners who say, 'Where is the God of Israel? He must be helpless!' "***

*Then the LORD will pity his people and be indignant for the honor of his land! **He will reply, "Look! I am sending you grain and wine and olive oil, enough to satisfy your needs. You will no longer be an object of mockery among the surrounding nations. I will remove these armies from the north and send them far away. I will drive them back into the parched wastelands, where they will die. Those in the rear will go into the Dead Sea; those at the front will go into the Mediterranean. The stench of their rotting bodies will rise over the land." Surely the LORD has done great things! Don't be afraid, my people! Be glad now and rejoice because the LORD has done great things. Don't be afraid, you animals of the field! The pastures will soon be green. The trees will again be filled with luscious fruit; fig trees and grapevines will flourish once more. Rejoice, you people of Jerusalem! Rejoice in the LORD your God! For the rains he sends are an expression of his grace. Once more the autumn rains will come, as well as the rains of spring. The threshing floors will again be piled high with grain, and the presses will overflow with wine and olive oil. The LORD says, "I will give you back what you lost to the stripping locusts, the cutting locusts, the swarming locusts, and the hopping locusts. It was I who sent this great destroying army against you. [Joel 2:15-25 \(NLT\)](#)***
