

# Weekly Morning Meditations

## ‘The LORD Will Make A Way’

### Monday

#### A WAY THROUGH DARKNESS

*He revealeth the deep and secret things: he knoweth what is in the darkness, and the light dwelleth with him. Daniel 2:22 [KJV]*

**DARK** hidden; secret; not easily understood; gloomy hopeless; angry; without light; evil, sinister

#### HIS POWER

*I form the light, and create darkness: I make peace, and create evil: I the Lord do all these things. Isaiah 45:7*

#### HIS PRESENCE

*Yea, the darkness hideth not from thee; but the night shineth as the day: the darkness and the light are both alike to thee. Psalm 139:12*

#### HIS PLACE

*He made darkness his secret place; his pavilion round about him were dark waters and thick clouds of the skies. Psalm 18:11*

#### HIS PROVIDENCE

*Thou makest darkness, and it is night: wherein all the beasts of the forest do creep forth. Psalm 104:20*

#### HIS PROMISES

*For thou art my lamp, O Lord: and the Lord will lighten my darkness. 2 Samuel 22:29 (see also Psalm 18:28)*

*Who is among you that feareth the Lord, that obeyeth the voice of his servant, that walketh in darkness, and hath no light? let him trust in the name of the Lord, and stay upon his God. Isaiah 50:10*

### Wednesday

#### A WAY THROUGH DEATH

*For to me to live is Christ, and to die is gain. Philip. 1:21 [KJV]*

**DEATH** the act or fact of dying [cease to exist; stop functioning; stop living; become weak, faint, unimportant; fade or wither away]; total destruction; permanent ending of all life

#### THE ‘BENEFITS’ OF DEATH

- **it leads to SIGHT**  
*In the year that king Uzziah died I saw also the Lord... Isaiah 6:1 [KJV]*
- **it is a prerequisite to LIFE**  
*....like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. Romans 6:4 [KJV]*
- **it is an essential of LOVE**  
*We know that we have passed from death unto life, because we love the brethren. 1 John 3:14 [KJV]*
- **it forces us to TRUST GOD**  
*But we had the sentence of death in ourselves, that we should not trust in ourselves, but in God which raiseth the dead: 2 Cor. 1:9 [KJV]*
- **it compels us to SEEK GOD**  
*....Thus saith the Lord, Set thine house in order: for thou shalt die, and not live. Then Hezekiah turned his face toward the wall, and prayed unto the Lord, Isaiah 38:1-2 [KJV]*
- **it is PRECIOUS to GOD**  
*Precious in the sight of the Lord is the death of his saints. Psalm 116:15 [KJV]*

### Friday

#### A WAY THROUGH DESTRUCTION

*To deliver such an one unto Satan for the destruction of the flesh, that the spirit may be saved in the day of the Lord Jesus. 1 Cor. 5:5 [KJV]*

**DESTRUCTION** the act or process of tearing down; demolish; break up or spoil completely; ruin; crush; bring to total defeat; put an end to; make useless

#### THE WAY THROUGH DESTRUCTION IS A ROAD CALLED ‘MERCY’

**MERCY** a refraining from harming or punishing offenders, enemies, persons in one’s power, etc.; kindness in excess of what may be expected or demanded by fairness

#### EXAMPLES

*And David said unto Gad, I am in a great strait: let us fall now into the hand of the Lord; for his mercies are great: and let me not fall into the hand of man. 2 Samuel 24:14 [KJV]*

*It is of the Lord's mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not. Lament. 3:22 [KJV]*

*Nevertheless for thy great mercies' sake thou didst not utterly consume them, nor forsake them; for thou art a gracious and merciful God. Neh. 9:31 [KJV]*

*(For the Lord thy God is a merciful God;) he will not forsake thee, neither destroy thee, nor forget the covenant of thy fathers which he swore unto them. Deut. 4:31 [KJV]*

*When I said, My foot slippeth; thy mercy, O Lord, held me up. Psalm 94:18 [KJV]*
